1.	Minutes and actions from the last meetings of the Adults and Children's Board were reviewed and agreed as an accurate record. The matters arising are covered by the agenda.

2.	 Emotional Wellbeing Summit (originally scheduled for mid-October) The reasons for the proposed Mental Health summit were explained. The SSP explained that when they had undertaken a scoping and fact-finding mission to understand where people thought the issues were in the system it was found that there are sufficient plans and strategies in place across systems with a systemic shortfall in the early identification stage. They confirmed that this work is being led and corralled up by Public Health, through the Mental Health Committee. The SSP Board Chair confirmed he would now be a member of the Mental Health committee, and this also involves keeping the 10-year strategy under continuous review. The work undertaken by the SSP will be fedback to the next Mental Health Committee. Actions/Decision: The SSP Board Chair will attend the Mental Health Committee and will feedback to the SSP on and exception basis.
3.	All-age issues: Learning from case review analysis over the past 2 years
	A deep dive looking at learning from case reviews from the last two years had been conducted, this follows on from a ten-year review previously conducted. The SSP have reviewed this work and overlapped the themes from this review with the SSP priorities for the next year. The main themes from this review were as follows:
	 Professional Curiosity Better Information Sharing Place of safety Identification of risk
	Involving fathers came through as a strong theme along with better support for children with complex health needs.

	The metrics within the SSP are currently being worked on in conjunction with SODA.
4.	The Partnership's work programme for the second half of the business year (October 22- March 23)
	The SSP work programme is currently being reviewed in order to plan coherently for the second half of the business year (October 2022 to March 2023). Board members were asked to look at which few programs they should be focused on over the next 6 months including, looking at an outcome-based approach.
	The SSP consultation had been circulated and consulted on. The consultation was circulated with the agenda.
	The SSP will be holding an away day on Monday 26 September, and this will look at the feedback from this consultation and help direct the way forward.
	It was agreed to take this feedback into the SSP away day on Monday and the document will be shared virtually with people after this event.
